9. vague, clear

The book was vague. The book was clear.
The teacher was vague. The teacher was clear.

10. clean, dirty

The room is clean. The room is dirty.
The clothes are clean. The clothes are dirty.

11. early, late

The student is early. The student is late.
The food is early. The food is late.

12. fast, slow

The car is fast. The car is slow.
The train is fast. The train is slow.

13. good, bad

The movie is good. The movie is bad.
The music is good. The music is good.

14. short, tall

The basketball player is short. The basketball player is tall.
My niece is short. My niece is tall.

15. thin, fat

The preacher is thin. The preacher is fat.
The police officer is thin. The police office is fat.

16. same, different

The hat is the same. The hat is different.
The story is the same. The story is different

17. close, far

The store is close. The store is far.
The restaurant is close. The restaurant is far.

18. sick, healthy

My mother is sick. My mother is healthy.
My horse is sick. My horse is healthy.

19. right, wrong

The woman is right. The woman is wrong.
My nephew is right. My nephew is wrong.

20. polite, rude

My grandfather is polite. My grandfather is rude.
The boss is polite. The boss is rude.
